# OH direction for flu and COVID season readiness and response

Ontario Health direction was received earlier this month to help primary care and other health care providers prepare for the anticipated flu and COVID surge this fall and winter.

#### Primary care:

- Continue prevention and care of respiratory illness for patients through testing, immunization, and treatment
- Review Ontario Health's <u>website</u> for resources related to COVID-19 treatment



## Flu and COVID season readiness and response (cont'd)

New resources include:

- Ontario Health Recommendations for Outpatient Use of Intravenous Remdesivir (Veklury) in Adults
- Information about how to access antiviral treatments for COVID-19 in the community

Ministry of Health's <u>COVID-19 Vaccine-Relevant Information and Planning Resources</u>
Review <u>Infection prevention and control guidance</u> from the Ontario College of Family Physicians. Ensure adequate PPE supplies are on hand.

• Register and order supplies through the provincial <u>PPE Supply Portal</u>.

Continue to order COVID-19 PCR testing supplies through your usual channels, and order COVID-19 rapid antigen tests through the provincial <u>PPE Supply Portal</u> to distribute to your patients.

#### Ontario Breast Screening Program (OBSP) Updates

As of October 16, 2023 the following policy changes have been implemented:

#### **Screening Trans and Non-binary People**

Eligible trans and non-binary people can be screened in the OBSP

- Sites were provided guidance documents in July to prepare and ensure they are going to provide safe and inclusive services
- Eligible trans and non-binary people who are already being screened in the OBSP may begin receiving letters from OH-Cancer Care Ontario

Eligibility includes:

- Transfeminine people: 5+ consecutive years of feminizing hormone therapy and who are otherwise eligible. No documentation is required.
- Transmasculine people: no top surgery and who are otherwise eligible.

#### **Inclusion of People with Breast Implants**

Eligible people with breast implants can be screened in the OBSP.

- Sites were provided with guidance documents on screening people with implants in July
- Appointments will include two additional images per breast for participants
