ConnectMyHealth: you can now view your health records online



In Burlington, *ConnectMyHealth* provides patients and caregivers with online, single access to view health records from many healthcare facilities in Southwestern Ontario. It can be used on desktop and mobile devices. There's no cost to use it, and there's no app to download when accessing an online account.

ConnectMyHealth combines various types of health records created at Ontario Health West Region hospitals where patients have been treated into one, consolidated view.

Patients can view their electronic medical information aggregated from a variety of source systems across Ontario Health West Region including:

- Radiology reports and their corresponding images (where available)
- Cardiology-related reports and images (where available)
- Laboratory test results
- Clinical reports, such as discharge summaries from hospital visits
- Select medication information
- Allergies documented while in hospital
- Pathology and Genetics reports
- Details of past and upcoming hospital visits (where available)
